Choose Share Copy/Paste link in email, Slack, or any method of communication or send an email directly from the web.

Right-click the file on the mapped drive and choose "Copy Link" Paste link in email, Slack, or any method of communication.

Edit the file using the mapped drive or WebEdit.

You're done! No need to send again.
